Volume - up to 8 pages in MS Word (in doc; docx format); A4 paper size; page orientation: portrait with width alignment with 20 mm margins on all sides; font: Times New Roman (font size - 14); line spacing - 1.5.

The languages of the abstracts are Ukrainian, English, Romanian, Polish, Bulgarian.

The file name should be in the language of the abstract and consist of the author's (authors') surname, initials, lowercase underscore, and the word "abstract" without spaces (e.g., "Ivanov I._abstracts", "Ivanov I._tezy").

The information about the author (co-author) of the abstract should be centered: surname, initials in Ukrainian (in case of submitting the abstract in other languages - in English), academic degree, academic title, honorary title, position, place of work, locality, country, ORCID ID, e-mail address).

The title of the abstract should be indicated in bold, capital letters with centered alignment, without abbreviations and letter abbreviations. If the abstract is written in Ukrainian, the title should also be indicated in English.

Abstract: in English (up to 150 words).

Key words: in English (up to 10 words).

In the text, references are indicated in square brackets with the serial number of the source in the list; if necessary, the page number(s) are separated by commas.

Volume - up to 5 pages in MS Word (in doc; docx format); A4 paper size; page orientation: portrait with width alignment with 20 mm margins on all sides; font: Times New Roman (font size - 14); line spacing - 1.5.

The languages of the abstracts are Ukrainian, English, Romanian, Polish, Bulgarian.

The file name should be in the language of the abstract and consist of the author's (authors') surname, initials, lowercase underscore, and the word "abstract" without spaces (e.g., "Ivanov I._abstracts", "Ivanov I._tezy").

The information about the author (co-author) of the abstract should be centered: surname, initials in Ukrainian (in case of submitting the abstract in other languages -

in English), applicant (indicating the year of study), specialty, name of the higher education institution, information about the supervisor (indicating the surname, initials, academic degree, academic title, honorary title, position and place of work).

The title of the abstract should be indicated in boldface capital letters with center alignment, without abbreviations and letter abbreviations in the language of the abstract.

In the text, references are indicated in square brackets with the serial number of the source in the list; if necessary, the number of the page(s) is separated by a comma.
