Requirements for the preparation of conference abstracts:

- the length of the abstract should not exceed 4 A4 pages, including the list of references.
- font – Times New Roman, size - 14, style - Normal, line spacing - 1.5; margins: top, bottom, left, right - 20 mm;
- first line – author's first and last name (in full) (in bold, aligned to the right);
- the following lines - position and place of work (study), academic degree, academic title (in italics, aligned to the right edge);
- followed by the title of the report in capital letters (bold font, centred on the line);
- the text of the report is then placed, aligned in width (paragraph indentation - 125 mm);
- pages are not numbered;
- references to sources in the text should be indicated by a sequential number in the list of references (consecutive numbering), enclosed in square brackets with the page number of the source (if available), for example [3, p. 7];
- the list of references should be placed at the end of the text in accordance with the requirements of State standards of Ukraine 8302:2015 ‘Information and documentation. Bibliographic references. General requirements and rules for compilation’.
- materials should be submitted in electronic form in doc or docx format.

It is prohibited to cite in the text and include in bibliographic lists sources published in Russian in any country, as well as sources in other languages if they are published in

Russia and Belarus. Authors are personally responsible for the accuracy of the material presented, the accuracy of quotations, statistical data, and proper names. Abstracts must not contain state secrets or official information.
