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Guidelines for the formatting of conference abstracts:

- the abstract should be no more than 4 A4 pages in length, including the list of references;
- font – Times New Roman, font size – 14, style – Normal, line spacing – 1.5; margins: top, bottom, left, right – 20 mm;
- first line – the author's first name and surname (in full) (in semi-bold, right-aligned);
- the following lines – position and place of work (study), academic degree, academic title (in italics, right-aligned);
- followed by – the title of the paper in capital letters (in bold, centred on the line);
- the text of the report follows, justified (paragraph indent – 125 mm);
- the pages are not numbered;
- in-text references to sources should be indicated by their sequential number in the reference list (continuous numbering), enclosed in two square brackets and followed by the page number of the source (if available), for example [3, p. 7];
- the list of references should be placed at the end of the text – in accordance with the requirements of DSTU 8302:2015 «Information and documentation. Bibliographic references. General requirements and rules for compilation».
- materials must be submitted electronically in .doc or .docx format.

It is prohibited to cite in the text or include in bibliographies any sources published in Russian in any country, as well as sources in other languages if they are published within the territory of Russia and Belarus. Authors bear personal responsibility for the accuracy of the material presented, the accuracy of quotations, statistical data and proper names. Abstracts must not contain state secrets or classified information.
